

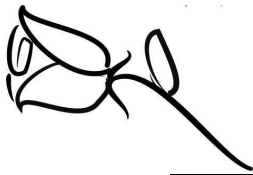

Wright is passionate about helping children and seniors who cannot speak for themselves, and strives to help women learn about finances.

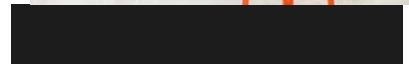
At home, she enjoys time with her two sons, Cory and Christian, and her granddaughter, Madeline.

The online voter guide is being used this year for the first time, for local candidates., such as Trustees and Council Members. Registered voters can enter the address where they are registered to vote, and see the local candidates and issues that will appear on their ballot.

Candidates are invited to participate and enter their own information and provide a link to their campaign website, and to a YouTube video about why they are running for the office.

The voter can compare contested races' candidate information side by side, and create their own marked ballot to use as reference when they vote, or to share on social media. We hope all the candidates will take advantage of this free visibility opportunity, so that Clermont's voters have the information they need to cast their ballot.

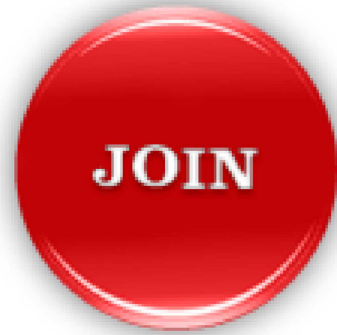
